### Marist Spirituality: Presenting the Image

What is your image of God our Father? Some people in our present-day world see God as someone who is beyond our reach or understanding, as someone who is indifferent. To them God is a judgmental figure who weighs our faults on a scale and punishes accordingly. Their God, their heavenly Father, is someone harsh and to be feared rather than loved. If this is your image of God, you might search for another. If you aren't sure of what that image might be, consider Jesus. He is the Son of God and, more than anyone else, knows what our heavenly Father is really

like. In fact, Jesus is the likeness of God. He is someone loving and welcoming, forgiving and merciful. He understands life's joys and struggles, pains and sorrows, and the everyday battles that all of us go through. He doesn't wait for the lame and the troubled to come to him, but goes out to meet them wherever they are. When he does encounter them, he is moved with compassion. So, too, is the God he mirrors.

Marist spirituality invites us to carry on the work of Christ, to image for others who God really is and the depth of God's love. Marist Father Craig Larkin reminds us that at the Annunciation Mary was asked to be the mother of Jesus and that she responded with a resounding and faith-filled YES. In doing so, she gave birth to Jesus who is the image of God. It was through the words and wonders of Jesus that people came to see, hear and feel the presence of God in their lives.

Can we, too, give a resounding and faith-filled YES as Mary did? Can we, too, be Christ-like and bring to others an all-embracing and loving image of God? Can we at least try? Brother Roy, S.M.
