People are Fragile

Marist Father John Sajdak, when asked to comment on what impressed him most about the founder of the Marist Fathers and Brothers, replied that there was one characteristic about John Claude Colin that stood out. It was his awareness of how fragile every person is and just how much Marists need to be sensitive to the situation people find themselves in. They may be going through the grief that comes through the loss of a loved one. They may be experiencing deep guilt after having had an abortion. They may be suffering from mental anguish or physical illness. Whatever their situation, it is not judgment that is needed. It is mercy and understanding.

John Claude Colin urged every Marist to be sensitive to the situation others find themselves in and to approach them with a gentleness that seeks to comfort and encourage rather than intimidate or frighten. Colin knew how easily people become "broken" and so he often reminded Marists that it was through Jesus and Mary that broken hearts could become mended. He exhorted Marists to be present to others by supporting them, seeking to understand them, and embracing them with the same love that Christ and Mary have for all God's people.

As a Marist people and a Marist parish, let's continue to put into practice what John Claude Colin taught.
