### Parish House Collection

The Parish House annual **Backpack Distribution** is nearing an end! You still have time to shop for school items for Upshur County students, though the collection will end on July 31<sup>st</sup>. Filling backpacks takes place the first week of August and distribution will be the second week of August. Here is the general needs list: backpacks for Elementary – 15 inch or larger, larger backpacks for Middle School & High School – 17 inch or larger, packs of markers, safety scissors for elementary students, packs of 24 count Crayola crayons, highlighters, packs of wide-ruled loose leaf filler paper, packs of college-ruled loose leaf filler paper, pink eraser blocks (rectangles, not small pencil top erasers), sticks, single subject spiral notebooks, pocket folders, pencil sharpeners, pencils, pens, blank index cards (note cards), toothbrush, toothpaste, hand sanitizer, hair brush and comb, deodorant. ### Diaper Bank Totals for June

During the month of June the Diaper Bank at the Parish House distributed 71 boxes of diapers and 39 packs of wipes. In total, we helped 45 families with these donations. We can always use size 4 diapers to replenish our stock. Thanks to all of our generous parishioners who help with this project.

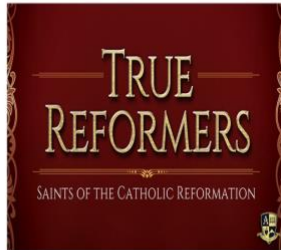
