### **Inquiry Class to Continue**

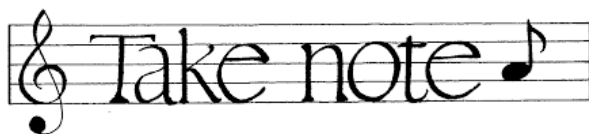
