### "Journey Through the Bible" Holy Land Pilgrimage – January 14-24, 2020

Father Leonard Smith, a priest of the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston, will be leading a 10-day pilgrimage to the Holy Land January 14-24, 2020 through Educational Opportunities Catholic Tours. You are invited to join us as we journey through the land where Jesus was born, spent his youth, called his apostles, was baptized in the Jordan, fed the five thousand, shared his last supper with his disciples, prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, died on the cross, rose from the dead, and appeared to his disciples until the day of his ascension to the Father. During our pilgrimage, we will pray at all of these sacred places, and will celebrate Holy Mass daily in places such as Jericho, Bethlehem, Mount Carmel, the Mount of Beatitudes, Nazareth, the Mount of Olives, and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem's Old City. We will renew our baptismal promises at the Jordan River, renew wedding vows at Cana, and even sail on the Sea of Galilee. Each day, we will have the chance to enjoy sumptuous buffet breakfasts and dinners, and spend restful evenings in first class hotels in Bethlehem, Tiberius, and Jerusalem.

All-Inclusive pricing starts at \$3,196 from New York (\$3,394 from Washington-Dulles Airport). Optional extensions in Jerusalem, and to Egypt and Jordan are also available.
