## Norms for Reopening Parish Facilities

The Diocese of Wheeling Charleston has issued updated guidelines for reopening parish facilities for meetings and gatherings. Although the guidelines still require social distancing and mask wearing, parish meetings may be held with care and preparation. No food or drink is permitted at any meeting and gatherings such as funeral luncheons, wedding receptions, baby showers, etc. are still not permitted. ## Dispensation

As the church begins the “Year of St. Joseph,” our diocese will begin it’s own celebration of the Solemnity of the Feast of St. Joseph, March 19. This solemnity falls on a Friday during Lent, so the obligation to abstain from meat is dispensed. Canon Law tells us; “Abstinence from eating meat or some other food according to the prescripts of the conference of bishops is to be observed on every Friday of the year unless a Friday occurs on a day listed as a solemnity” (Canon 1251). Thus Bishop

Mark has reminded us that we can celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph with meals containing meat.
