

Mark Cerullo has been diagnosed with Waldenstroms Macroglobulinemia which is a rare white blood cell cancer. It is a slow-growing type of non-Hodgkin lymphoma. Waldenström's mostly forms in the bone marrow and can slow the growth of normal blood cells, which can lead to anemia and a weakened immune system. One in 3.5 million people get this cancer. Although insurance has covered some things, there are many, many other expenses involved in treating this disease. Mark's wife, Rhonda was just diagnosed last week with lung cancer. Rhonda has been cancer free for 10 years up until now. They will be going through treatments at the same time.


