

Friday, April 18, noon: – Stations of the Cross (The church will be open from noon until 3 p.m. for private prayer.)

Friday, April 18, 7 p.m: – Liturgy of the Word, Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion Saturday, April 19, 8 p.m: – Mass and blessing of the paschal candle; we recall our Baptism

Sunday, April 20, 9 a.m: Easter Mass of the Resurrection

#### **Third Scrutiny**

The words of the hymn, "I Now Live," echo faintly in churches still decorated for Lent as the Third Scrutiny takes place and those who journey toward Easter hear about the raising of Lazarus. The Gospel story is about



more than just the raising of a single man, but about the life that Jesus Christ offers to every one of us. But there are many powers that seek to steal this life from us. In the words of this Scrutiny we pray for those journeying toward Easter, as the presider says: "Free from the grasp of death those who await your life-giving sacraments and deliver them from the spirit of corruption." It is through the sacrament of the Church that Jesus Christ instituted that we receive a new life, but sin stands in our way. But what Jesus did for his

friend in this story, he did for us through his cross and resurrection. If we choose life, there is no spirit that can stand against us. May we stand with those before us who will be baptized at Easter and testify to the reality that we now live because we have died and risen with him and death's power is no more.

#### **OCIA Catechumens**

This weekend we welcome our Holy Rosary OCIA catechumens during our Sunday liturgy. OCIA is the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults and Tammy Malcolm, Brogan Malcolm, and Dee Dee Elliott have been preparing for the Easter sacraments for a good while. We pray for them as they complete their final weeks of preparation and ask our Lord to bless them and make them holy. They will receive the sacraments of Initiation on Easter Sunday.

#### Be a Part of our Garden

Earlier in March, we remembered the feast day of St. Joseph, Jesus's foster father, patron saint of the universal church, and patron saint of fathers. Some years ago, we dedicated a rock garden to this beloved protector of Mary and Jesus. Families brought a large rock and placed it in the garden.
