#### Welcome Our Mission Statement



#### **Our First Corpus Christi Procession!**

ecently, Father Ed wrote an article explaining the WHY of a Corpus Christi procession. This article is the HOW of the procession.

Our very first Corpus Christi procession will take place Sunday, June 11 immediately following our Sunday Liturgy. After Mass, please gather at the front on the sidewalk with the altar servers following the priest. The congregation will be behind the altar servers. The Knights of Columbus will bring up the rear of the procession. At Father Ed's signal, we will begin our procession. This is a very solemn procession. We are honoring the Blessed Sacrament, our Holy Eucharist, the gift that our Lord gives to sustain us, protect us, and to keep us faithful to Him. We will do this in a very prayerful manner.

We will first walk to City Hall where we will pray and sing to the Eucharist and for our county. We will then walk to Jawbone Park, again singing and praying, this time for our beautiful state. We will follow up by walking to the Courthouse again with prayers and singing, this time for our country. We will return to Marist Hall for a lovely reception in honor of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO WALK THIS PROCESSION, you may choose to station yourself at any of the three stops and participate in that way. There should be plenty of parking since this is a Sunday.

Be sure to attend the reception in Marist Hall afterwards. You will receive your program after mass on June 11. We hope that you will be in attendance to honor our Blessed Sacrament.

#### **Attention Lectors**

During the summer, we will not have a cantor or musician on Saturday evenings. If you are reading at a Saturday evening liturgy, please make sure that if you are the first reader, you should also read the psalm response. If you are the second reader, please also read the gospel acclamation and the prayers of the faithful. (The prayers of the faithful are located on the cantor's stand in a white binder.) This is for Saturday evening only until the end of summer.

#### **Teens Encounter Christ (TEC)**

After a 3-½-year hiatus, the Diocese will have its first "Mountain State TEC" Retreat, at St. Mary Parish, in Morgantown (Star City), on June 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>. This **Teens Encounter Christ** weekend is intended for rising High School Juniors through rising College Freshmen (roughly 15 to 19-year-olds). Its purpose is to help older teens grow closer to God and to a community of young people and adults, in and through Jesus Christ. It will consist of prayer, talks, activities, community building, games,

music, fun, food, and the Sacraments. It begins on the Saturday morning and ends on the Monday afternoon. 


