

Join in the Hunger Walk

On Saturday, October 1st, the Upshur Parish House will host the first-ever Mark Petrosky Memorial Hunger Walk to fight food insecurity, benefitting the food pantry and holiday food box programs. Registration beings at 8:30 AM at the Upshur Parish House located at 68 College Avenue, Buckhannon, and the walk begins at 9:00 AM. Participants are encouraged to donate a minimum of \$5.00 and/or a bag filled with nonperishable food. Items most in need include traditional Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday meal food such as boxed stuffing, green beans, corn, yams, evaporated milk, gravy packets, and pie crust mix. Other items that are always needed in the food pantry are pork n' beans, jelly, canned fruit, oats, dish soap, and feminine hygiene supplies. The 1.5 mile walk will begin at the Upshur Parish House and go around the River Trail. It is named in memory of Mark Petrosky, a food pantry volunteer who passed away in 2021. Mark served his country in the U.S. Army and was a proud veteran and father. All are welcome and encouraged to wear orange for Hunger


