

## Gifts From the Holy Land

Coming to Holy Rosary on the weekend of April 17-19 are beautiful handmade olivewood carvings from the Holy Land. The Christians of the Holy Land have suffered and continue to live in difficult economic situations. Olivewood carvings are part of a tradition handed down from one generation to another. Christian families have worked over 2000 years to protect the holy sites in Bethlehem, Jerusalem, Nazareth, and to spread the word of Jesus. For the past 1000 years they used carvings to keep the Bible alive. Our mission is to support them by selling their olivewood carvings, one of the major sources of income. Proceeds from the sale will benefit Christian families in Bethlehem/Holy Land. Your support will help 200 families to remain in the Holy Land. ## Dispensation

As the church begins the "Year of St. Joseph," our diocese will begin its own celebration of the Solemnity of the Feast of St. Joseph, March 19. This solemnity falls on a Friday during Lent, so the obligation to abstain from meat is dispensed. Canon Law tells us; "Abstinence from eating meat or some other food according to the precepts of the

conference of bishops is to be observed on every Friday of the year unless a Friday occurs on a day listed as a solemnity" (Canon 1251). Thus Bishop Mark has reminded us that we can celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph with meals containing meat.

Catholic Sisters Week is celebrated March 8-14, 2021. Catholic Sisters have served our parishes from many different communities. 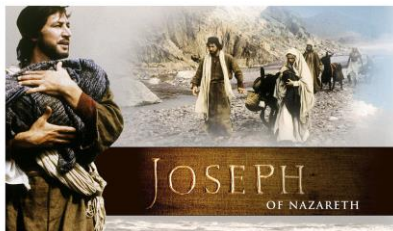
