

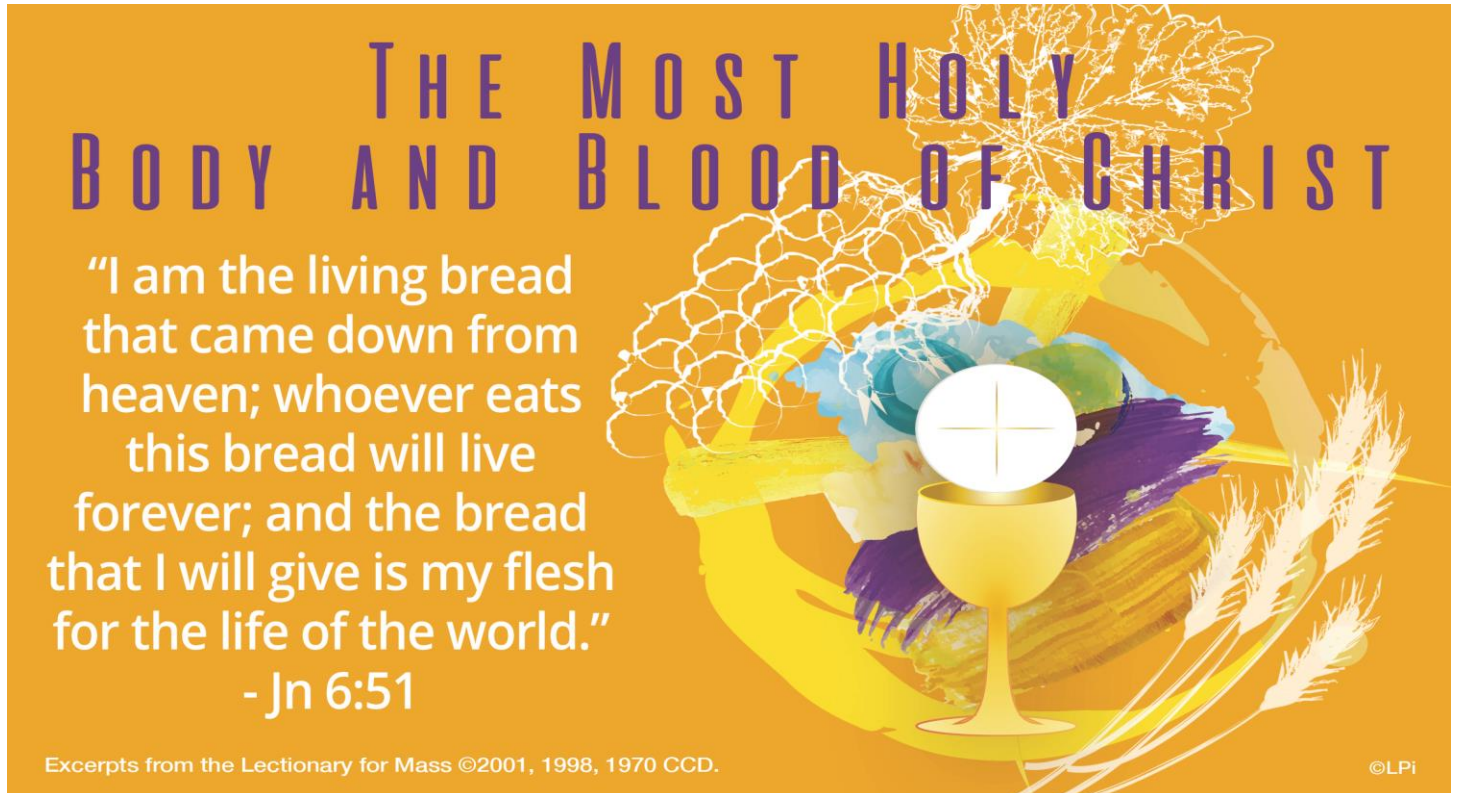

Bishops Encourage Faithful to Return to Mass as Dispensation is Lifted

When the Covid Pandemic began and our churches were closed, our bishops lifted the obligation to attend mass. Now that we are slowly getting back to normal, they have lifted that dispensation, and are encouraging the faithful to return to mass in person in a safe way for all. Parts of that document, which can be found on our Holy Rosary website, are below:

“Therefore, we are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation in the Archdiocese of Baltimore, the Archdiocese of Washington, and the Dioceses of Arlington, Richmond, Wheeling-Charleston, and Wilmington beginning on Saturday, June 26, 2021 and Sunday, June 27, 2021. We welcome and encourage the Faithful to return to full in-person participation of the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law, canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180).

This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus, another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult his or her local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (Canon 87).”

Our Bishop Mark has responded to this dispensation with a letter to the faithful of the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston. Both letters can be found on the diocesan website, dwc.org.

A Backpack Program Report

Dear Parishioners,

Yes, Holy Rosary continues to provide the Washington District Elementary School Backpack Program. The Program has provided nutritional week-end snacks for 32 students. This year 7/2020 to 6/2021 will be extended for four weeks this summer; this is a result of a covid-relief support from the state for education. Because of the previous year's

contributions from businesses, organizations, churches, and a donation from a trust, your program has survived. This year Holy Rosary has not received any donations from any outside source. This year's donations from you the Holy Rosary Parishioners was \$1,085. The expense for the year was \$ 3,592.79 (which does not include the weekly fresh fruit expense of approximately \$600 annually).

The rate is \$325.00 per child with scholarships available. \$275 Early Bird rates apply. Registration forms are on the diocesan website: dwc.org.

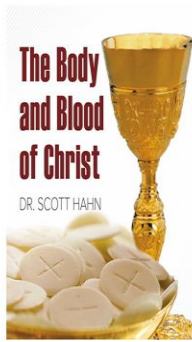
