

THE FIVE FIRST SATURDAYS DEVOTION

Dear Parishioners and friends,

God willing, starting next month, October 5th, which is the First Saturday, we will start The Five First Saturdays Devotion in our Parish. We will pray the Holy Rosary at 8:30 am and the celebrate Mass at 9 am.

On December 10, 1925, our Holy Mother Mary promised Sister Lucia of Fatima that she would “assist at the hour death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturdays of five consecutive months confess, receive Holy Communion, pray a Rosary, and keep Me Company for a quarter of an hour meditating on the fifteen mysteries with the intention of offering Me reparation.”

The intention is to console the Immaculate Heart of Mary, offer reparation for the blasphemies and ingratitude of unrepentant sinners, and for peace in the world.

Please note that this Morning Mass does not replace Saturday Vigil Mass. It is an obligation for all faithful Catholics to attend Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass. Kindly, see the bulletin for more information on this Five First Saturdays Devotion.
