#### 150 Years – Celebrating Bishop Whelan

Bishop Richard V. Whelan was born in Baltimore on January 28, 1809. Educated at Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg and the Seminary of St. Sulpice in Paris, he was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Richmond on May 1, 1831. Whelan served as pastor at Harpers Ferry and its missions at Martinsburg, Winchester, and Berkeley Springs, before being appointed second bishop of Richmond in late 1840. On July 19, 1850, he was appointed bishop of the newly-established Diocese of Wheeling. At the time of his assignment to Wheeling, there were only seven churches and chapels and six priests to supply a Catholic population estimated at 5,000 spread throughout western Virginia. Whelan shepherded our diocese until his death on July 7, 1874. During his pastorate Whelan grew the church in West Virginia to 55 churches and chapels, 29 priests, one hospital, one college, and orphan asylum, and an estimated 18,000 Catholic population.


