Second Collection

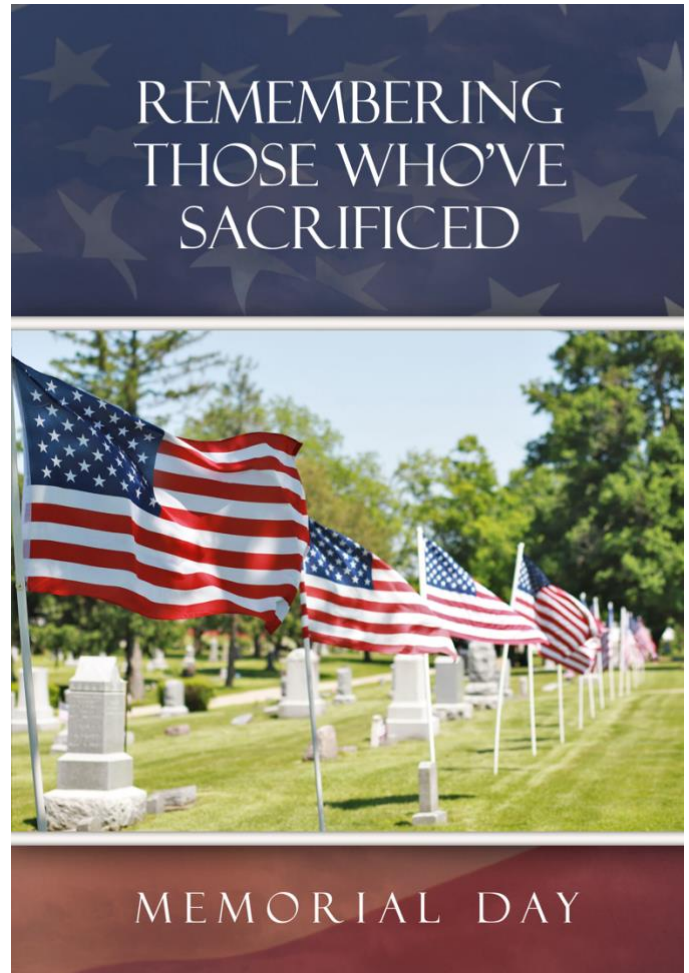

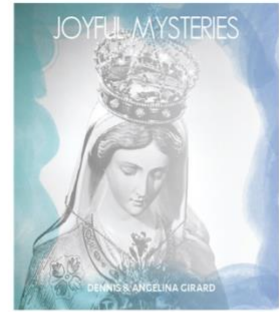
