*How can I ever thank You enough for this special gift?*

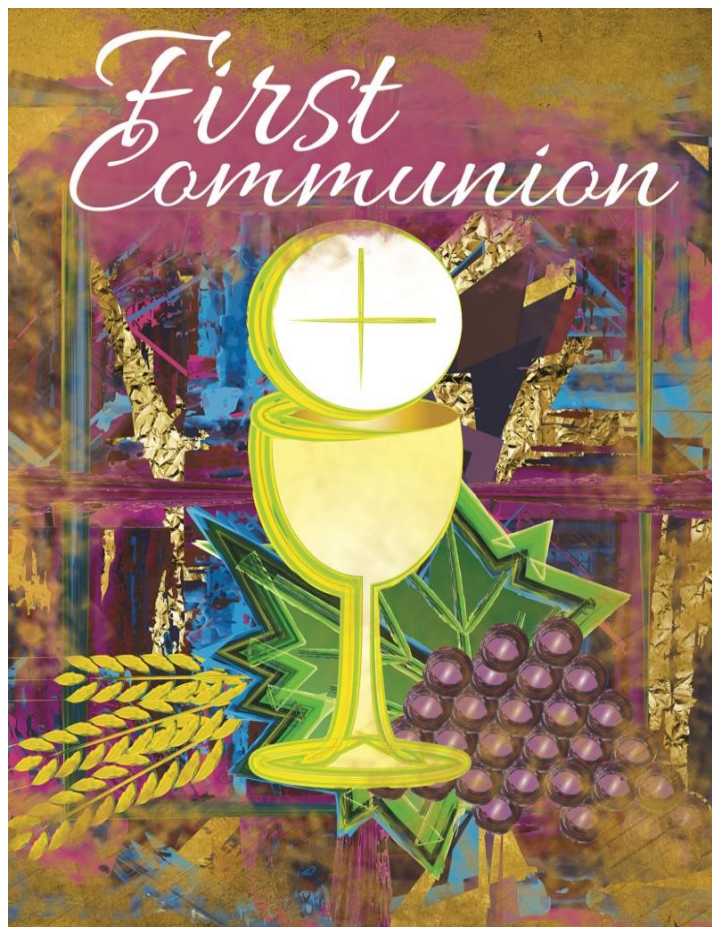
*At Mass we are called to be like Jesus, by loving and serving one another in the world.*
