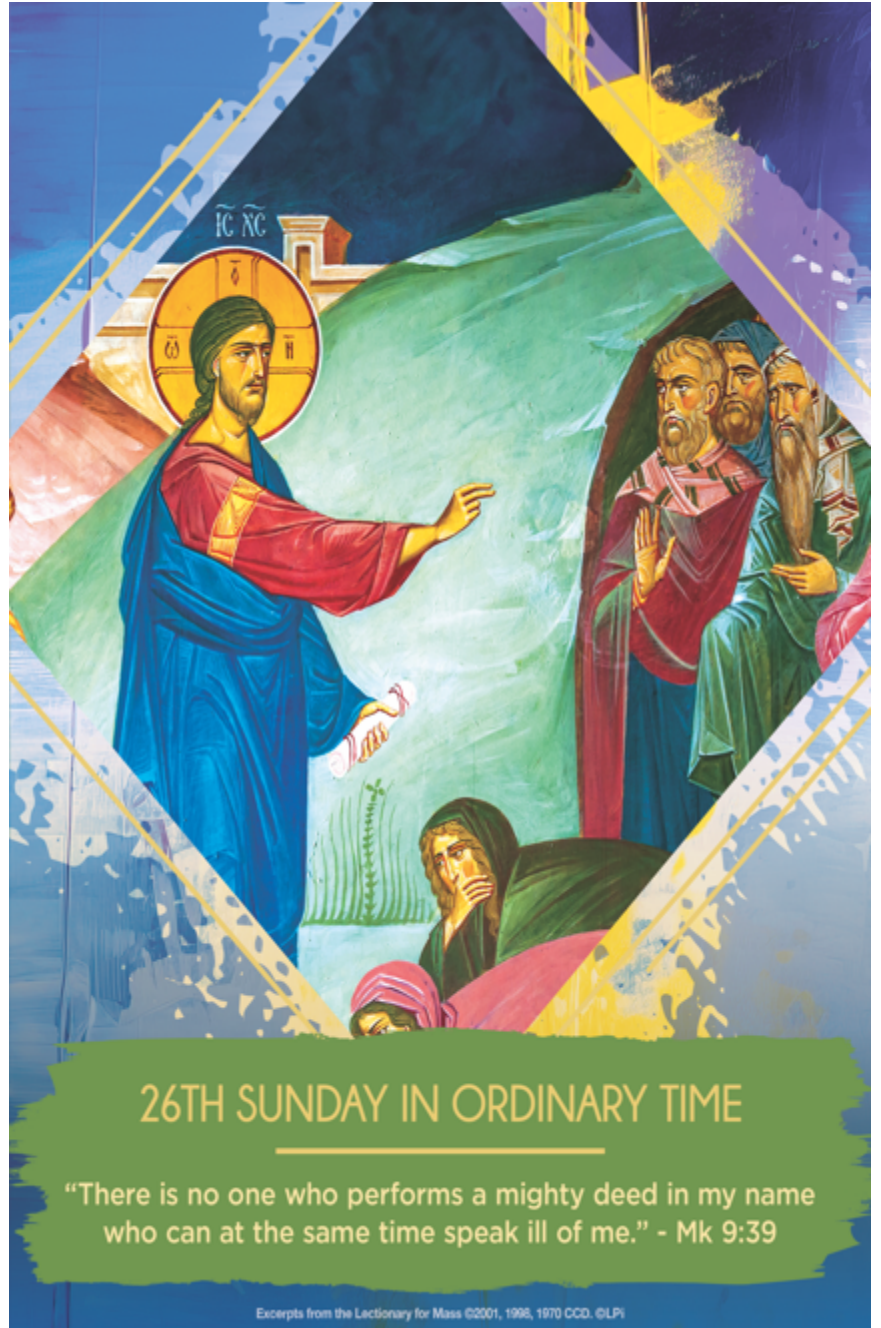

Sacraments

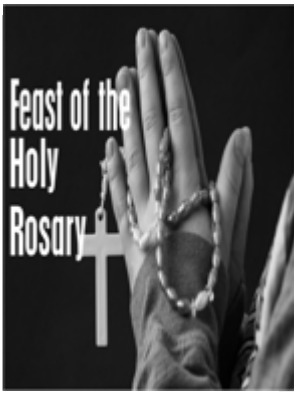
Baptism~ Please call the parish office to schedule an appointment for baptism preparation.

First Saturday

Starting October 5th, which is the First Saturday of the month, we will start “The Five First Saturdays Devotion” in our Parish. We will pray the Holy Rosary at 8:30 am and the Mass at 9 am.

On December 10, 1925, our Holy Mother Mary promised Sister Lucia of Fatima that she would “assist at the hour death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturdays of five consecutive months, confess, receive Holy Communion, pray a Rosary, and keep Me Company for a quarter of an hour meditating on the fifteen mysteries with the intention of offering Me reparation.”

Please note that this morning Mass does not replace Saturday Vigil Mass. It is an obligation for all faithful Catholics to attend Saturday Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass.


